The Domestic Relations Office provides social and mental health services support, supervised visitation and neutral exchanges, cooperative parenting group classes and a visitation enforcement program to the Civil District Courts

Consultation and Referral by DRO Director, Tony Neugebauer:

- Available to Judges entire day in DRO.
- Assessments of child expressed objectives and issue-specific child interviews, mediation-type collaboration with attorneys, parties, children, collaterals to narrow the issues in access/visitation issues. DRO contains Order of Referral to DRO that should be signed by attorneys and judge for this service.
- Triage for appropriate mental health services such as social studies, psychological evaluations, parent coordination, counseling and cooperative parenting classes.
- Assist judges and attorneys "match" evaluator to case.

Social Study Evaluators List:

- List available from DRO.
- Evaluators who meet state and local criteria.
- Limited pro bono evaluations if ordered by judge.

Cooperative Parenting Program Services:

- Court-ordered services for parents experiencing conflict in co-parenting.
- Group classes, 8 weeks, sliding fee scale

Bexar County Shared Parenting Program (formerly ACCESS Visitation Enforcement):

- Aids non-custodial parents with enforcement of visitation.
- Program requirements:
 - Valid final Bexar County court order with specific visitation terms.
 - Custodial parent and children reside in Bexar County.
 - Non-custodial parent unable to afford attorney and reside in Bexar or contiguous counties.
